12 Foundation Stones Class Tests/Equivalency Exam available

We are happy to let you know that the *12 Foundation Stones* Class Tests and Equivalency Exam are now available for downloading from the MO site. They will also later be sent on paper in a mailing to add to your *12 Foundation Stones* Teacher's Supplement binder. These tests can be printed and/or copied for your sheep, or sent by e-mail, as needed.

These tests have two purposes: One way to use them is as Class Tests following each class, for those who are going through the *12 Foundation Stones* course.—This is optional, and not a required part of the course. The other use for these tests is as an Equivalency Exam for those who have not had the actual course, but have had similar classes and are ready to become Active members. There is a more in-depth explanation of both ways to use these classes in the "Read Me" file that is included with the tests themselves.

Here's a clip from "The Family Membership Expands" (GN 1096), which explains the purpose of the Equivalency Exam:

"If your current sheep have already had classes covering the same basic topics as the 12 Foundation Stones, they may skip taking the 12 Foundation Stones course (which would mean retaking the same classes), and can become an Active member provided they first pass the '12 Foundation Stones Equivalency Exam.' This exam will show whether or not they have learned and understood the essential subjects taught in the 12 Foundation Stones course. If they don't pass, then they should be taught the 12 Foundation Stones classes for those topics which they have not yet learned."

We pray these exams will be a blessing for you and your current would-be Active members. We love you!

You Just Never Know

When I opened the Christmas mailing package last December, I groaned. I know I shouldn't have, but I did. There, in the package was another Christmas GN, imploring us to do our best to win as many souls as possible, as "this might be someone's last Christmas."

I almost protested. It sounded like the same thing I'd heard every year. We already work so hard at Christmas doing all those special things like following up on our contacts, making Christmas cookies for our friends, going caroling, provisioning special meals for our CTPs, etc. I'm sure we could fit in extra personal witnessing, but did we really need to exert ourselves? Wasn't Jesus happy with the souls we had already won for Him during the year?

Despite my doubts, our Home did put more of an emphasis on soul-winning than in previous years. Along with our personal witnessing, we hosted programs at schools where we told the story of Christmas, sang songs, and prayed with the children to receive Jesus. We won over 2,400 souls during Christmas, over two-thirds of them being children under the age of 12. We averaged three school programs a day for almost two weeks straight and it was mostly organized by three SGAs, including myself.

It was not an easy job and I was looking forward to December 27th when I was scheduled to have a three-day break and enjoy some Christmas vacation with my family and friends. But the much anticipated break never came.

On the morning of the 26th the tsunami struck the western coasts of Phuket, Thailand. The extent of the tragedy was soon to be known worldwide as one of the worst humanitarian crises in history. Besides the people who'd lost their livelihood and earthly possessions, there were many—far too many—who'd also lost their loved ones, as well as those who lost their lives.

A few days later, we met many children who had attended one of our Christmas programs and received Jesus during the shows. Some of the areas that were the worst hit were the very places we had performed at, and witnessed in, over Christmas. Some of the schools that were ruined were the ones we'd held English camps at. UNICEF announced that a large percentage of the casualties from this region were children who were helpless when the waves came. Indeed, for many, that *was* their last Christmas.

I will never know how many children or people that we witnessed to lost their lives on that Boxing Day. I don't need to. What this whole catastrophe brought out to me was how fragile human life is. A man's life is like a flower of the field, here today, gone tomorrow, blown away by the wind, or in this case, washed away by a wave of the sea. I shouldn't have needed a tsunami to wake me up to the realization that God means just what He says. Those pleas in the GN were not just pretty words that complete a Family Christmas tradition; they were real and were meant to spur me into action and obedience.

May we all do our part to win those souls for Him before next Christmas rolls around. Who knows what might happen between now and then?

How He Spurs Us On

A while back, the visa laws in Romania changed, creating stricter requirements for those who intended to get humanitarian aid worker visas. This situation got us quite desperate as to how to go about obtaining the necessary paperwork, as there was a fine if this was not done on time.

We prayed about the situation, and whether or not our Home should look into the possibility of opening an association in light of this law. Amidst His counsel, He also encouraged us that even though this change was difficult, it was a blessing in disguise—mainly in that it would help us as a Home with our persecution prep.

The Lord drew our attention to the GN "Pray, Obey and Prepare" (ML #3420), and stressed the importance for us to follow through on it right away. One morning for devotions we reviewed the main points and requirements listed in the GN. These can be summarized in the following paragraph:

(Mama:) Please pray against our enemies, pray for the Family, pray for yourselves, strengthen your follow-up programs, keep getting out Activated, get out the meat of the Word, build your work as the Lord has said, show the Family as a positive force in your community, feed your contacts and let them know who you are and what you stand for, and have conviction! Then you don't have to worry about persecution (par.37).

Peter also emphasized further in paragraph 79: "Talking about it is not enough. You must have an actual plan that you follow. Continue to hear from the Lord in prophecy each step until you have an effective, feasible plan of attack for putting into practice the instruction of this GN regarding your preparation for persecution."

Well, unfortunately, even though we had been talking about it ever since this GN came out, we hadn't actually taken the time to come up with an effective, feasible plan of attack. When we took a look at our outreach and compared it to the list Mama gave above, we realized that we had quite a bit to do. For example, in order to strengthen our follow-up programs we first needed to have one!

So far our follow-up has been quite haphazard and done out of inspiration. Even though we've never hidden the name of the Family and whenever we'd witness or do any projects we'd clearly say we're with the Family, still we realized that we could do much more in strengthening the influence of our work as a positive force in the community. And now with the tightening of the visa laws, it seemed to urge us to strengthen that side of our work.

We began a series of meetings on each outreach-related point. We had a meeting on organizing our follow up and making practical decisions in order for it to happen in a more coordinated and concerted manner. Since then, our Home has definitely made a push in the area of follow up. Now we've planned to meet each week to cover other points such as *Activated*, CTP, PR, Bible classes, feeding our sheep, etc.

When we asked the Lord about this change in the visa laws, He clearly instructed us to look into opening an association, as it would help strengthen our resolve to keep up our CTP/PR projects and appeal, as then we'd be legally required to perform those services.

He also said: "You're also my little 'cork' that can never be sunk, no matter how hard and ferociously the 'whale' of the System splashes its tail. You, My children, will always float and rise up victoriously for I've given you the keys of the Kingdom and they cannot be sunk. They'll keep you buoyant, and keep you afloat. You can claim this as My promise for both your visas and your persecution prep."

This really encouraged me that even though it gets difficult for us, the "cork" of the Family will not sink, but will stay buoyant through it all. Even if the ACs have been trying to hinder the Lord's work and make it harder and more controlled, their efforts will only bring glory to God and cause men to praise Him. Wow!

Before they left we gave each one an *Activated* mag. The gentleman who was in charge of the group had shared a little about his life and marriage, so we gave him the *Activated* that had just what he needed—counsel on relationships with people.

This whole situation is causing us to enlarge the influence of our work, proclaim the name of the Family as a positive force in the community, lead us to reach those of influence and minister to them, and all of this is ultimately contributing towards our persecution prep!

keeping Active members in mind; they are loving, intimate, and sometimes sensual, but also a bit less physically or sexually suggestive than some of our LJ songs in the past have been.

It's been Mama's hope and desire that the beautiful songs that we produce for the Family to love our wonderful Husband by can also reach and touch the lives of more people than those within our FD/MM/FM circle. As these songs are shared with those who love Jesus, but aren't yet aware of, or ready to receive, the full concept of the Loving Jesus Revelation, we pray that they will be brought closer into His arms and develop a fuller relationship with Him.

<u>Our Fight for Our Daughter's Life</u>

My daughter Eiko (13) has been suffering from anorexia since the age of nine. The symptoms started when she was nine, but at that time no one realized the cause was anorexia. Only a couple of years later, while on a trip to visit my mother, did we realize the seriousness of her situation. During this time Eiko and I talked together. and she poured out her heart to me about her fears regarding the condition her body was in, and how some nights she couldn't sleep because she was afraid of dying. She explained that she hardly ate anything, and her body wasn't feeling well.

After this, our Home had united desperate praver of deliverance for Eiko's condition. However, because of a lack of knowledge about anorexia and not taking enough time to study the Word on the topic, I didn't fully grasp the seriousness of it. Also, at this time, I wasn't too aware of the state of my children and what they were going through. Eiko improved a little after the united prayer, so we thought everything was okay. But there was still a very serious warfare waging inside her heart and mind, and at that time, the Enemy was winning.

One year later we again had to face the seriousness of her condition. It was a very busy year for me, as we had just relocated, and were adjusting to a new team. I was also busy with VS work, so I hadn't spent sufficient time with Eiko, to see how she was doing. Thankfully, the Lord encouraged us to take a little vacation with our children (ages 6–17), right in the middle of this busy time. It was then that we realized she wasn't eating much of the food that we were served.

I wish I had read and studied the "Fight for Life" GNs (MLs #3390–3393) much earlier than I did. This time around, I got desperate enough to search the Word, and from there truly understood how anorexia is really a vicious *spiritual* battle. This situation forced me to depend on the keys and our different spiritual weapons. I had to make a commitment to fight for her life, no matter what, until we came through victorious.

We spent time talking together, and she told me that she knew she had given in to the Enemy. I got very desperate. As we desperately fought and prayed for her victory, we began to see more clearly how very real Pan, Bacchus, and these demons really are.

The "Fight for Life" series was extremely helpful to us. We can't adequately express our thanks to Kristen for sharing her lessons and testimony, and for the counsel that Mama and the Lord gave.

It was a battle from morning till night, facing off those demons and using the weapons of the keys, prophecy, and praise. Sometimes it was very tiring. We found the counsel in the Word about teamworking and uniting as a Home to fight this battle was very necessary in order to win the victory. I am so thankful for the understanding and help that the whole Home showed to rescue the life of this one young girl.

At a particular low point we wrote a short prayer request-a cry for help to Mama. When Mama heard about Eiko's situation, she asked a few channels to receive some prophecies and counsel for us, and the Lord revealed some amazing spirit helpers who were helping us fight the battle. This was a tremendous encouragement to all of us who were supporting Eiko. And it gave us the extra strength that we needed to continue to fight the good fight of faith for her.

Eiko later told us that she had been crying every day, and had lost her will to live. and didn't even want to listen to the Word. But what kept her was the love that we gave her. The Lord showed me to take a walk with her every morning-a time that I had reserved for the Lord and me to spend together. But the Lord explained that I had to draw her under my wing and shower her with extra special doses of the His love, which the prophecy and counsel we received from Mama also confirmed. Later Eiko shared that those walks were the very thing that kept her going, even though she still didn't want to eat and at times didn't even want to live.

The turnaround came soon after we received the prophecies and counsel from Mama. Eiko and I started communicating with the spirit helpers mentioned in prophecy.

One day while praying desperately for her, I received a prophecy suggesting that we take her to Niigata to do relief work. (Niigata had recently experienced a heavy earthquake.) It seemed like a crazy idea as it was the middle of winter, with very cold temperatures and the possibility of snow. Since Eiko was very skinny at the time, she didn't have much strength or energy and wasn't doing so well spiritually either. Also, we didn't know what our accommodations or food would be like, all of which might not have been ideal for her.

After counseling and seeking the Lord further, He again confirmed that we should not only take Eiko, but *all* the kids as well! We received the verse, "As they went they were healed." Eiko was also memorizing this beautiful key promise, which encouraged me to step out by faith: "The keys are activated by your obedience, so proceed as if possessing, claiming their power each step of the way. Then, like the priests who carried the Ark into the river, and as their feet touched the water the water parted, so will it be done for you. The river of troubles, trials, and difficult situations will part, making way for you to cross on dry land."

It turned out that this was exactly part of the key to her victory. The Lord prepared warm weather and a very kind lady offered us a place to stay in the same city where the earthquake had occurred. (This lady and the other volunteer workers staying with her all received Jesus!) Eiko had a chance to encourage the earthquake victims and see many miracles.

We provisioned our meals, and even saw beautiful double rainbows three times while on our trip. To us, it was an encouragement from the Lord that He was fulfilling His promise and also blessing our stepping out by faith.

After this Niigata trip, something changed in Eiko. A desire to want to live and minister to others began to flicker in her heart. Soon after this, another thing happened that helped seal this victory. I was talking with her, and then the Lord's Spirit took over and I began rebuking and casting out the demons that were attacking her. This was obviously not me at all, but the power of the Lord exposing and ridding her of the demons that had been plaguing her. Right after this talk she went to bed, and the next time I saw her, her attitude was visibly changed. She became more receptive and cooperative, and began counseling with me and others about how to develop better eating habits.

She has now made great progress. Though she still has battles, she goes on the attack against them as she wants to recover to full health. Sometimes she gets discouraged because it's taking time for her to get back to her former weight and full health. Through this battle with anorexia the Lord has helped her to progress not only physically through working on her life and habits, but also spiritually, as she has had to forsake her independence and rebelliousness, and grow in humility, reaching out to others, forsaking her pride, etc. She has not attained perfection in any of these areas, as none of us have, but she is progressing daily and is now such a changed person and much easier to work and talk with.

She has also been a blessing in ministering to our Active members as she has shared her testimony at many Bible classes, and through that, quite a few people have gotten major victories over long-term depression, or in their walk with Jesus, etc.

We can't say enough how thankful we are to Mama and WS who sent us such wonderful counsel. Thank you to all those who supported us in prayer during that time, you have helped us win the victory.

<u>The Keys Have It!</u>

Two weapons empower each other

Philip (of Hannah), Canada: A lot has been said about the power of the keys and that we would become known as the people with the power of the keys. However, I had a hard time calling on the power of the keys in front of outsiders who don't know anything about them. In those situations I get hit with the Enemy's fear, "You can't call on the power of the keys. If you do, they're going to think you're some kind of weird cultist or something." So usually I don't say anything about the keys and just pray an "in Jesus' name" prayer. But recently the Lord gave me the faith to call upon the key power in such situations and He's blessed it each time.

The first time was at an auto repair shop, while getting the aircon in my car fixed. They had already been working for an hour on the van, cleaning out the lines, checking the compressor, and adding the air-conditioning fluid. They were just finishing pouring in the third can of liquid when for some reason the whole process stopped as it looked like the pipes were clogged. If that was the case, then all their work had been done in vain, though I would still have to pay for it, and the labor was not cheap. In desperation, I walked up to the two mechanics, whom I had been witnessing to for the entire hour, laid my hand on the engine and prayed for the

Lord to rectify the problem right away and then I claimed the power of the keys.

Not more than ten seconds later the pressure started building up again and everything went fine. When the mechanic's wife came over to see how things were going, her husband told her the testimony. "Well, things were stuck there for a bit, but the man laid hands on the engine and prayed and now everything is fine!" In the end they even gave a discount.

The next day, while my eldest daughter (former member) was visiting, I prepared to make a phone call to one of our friends. I needed to ask this man for a short-term loan to purchase a motorhome that we had found, but I was really perplexed about how much to ask him for. My carnal mind told me to just ask for a portion of the money needed, but I knew that even that wouldn't be much of a help as we weren't able to cover the rest of the cost.

I asked my daughter to pray with me, and I desperately prayed for wisdom in knowing what to ask him. As I was praying, it came to the point where I had to decide whether to claim the power of the keys or just leave it at that, as my daughter didn't know about the keys. I opted for the keys. No sooner had I finished praying when the telephone rang and it was this very friend on the line. I explained the situation to him and went ahead in faith and asked for the full amount

needed, which was three times more than what I'd originally planned to ask him for. He readily agreed, and within two days the money was in the bank.

Later, while taking my quiet time and reflecting on this decision, I realized how important that one decision was and how much depended on it. If I hadn't had the faith to ask for the full amount I probably would have missed this golden opportunity to receive the full supply the Lord wanted to give us.

The Lord also reminded me that on the days of these miracles, I had also spent extra time in the morning loving Him. He told me that these miracles were my reward for loving Him intimately and spending extra time with Him. Incredibly enough, that person subscribed and is still being followed up on by my former Home in Delhi. Just think what I could have achieved if I'd been faithful to win many more souls last year. So, how many souls have I failed?

Aren't we all the same Family?

I went through a tough period in 2003 and was wounded in battle, as I like to put it. We had been on a tough mission field five years, doing all we could to serve the Lord and flood this land with the words of David.

During that time I began to get hit with anxiety attacks, which soon became a frequent occurrence. As the situation didn't get any better, even though I desperately prayed against it, I became quite depressed. My wife and Home did their best to help me; they prayed for my deliverance, rebuked every demon in the book, yet still the depression lingered. I desperately hung on to the keys, memorizing them continually in order to stay afloat. I felt like Jesus must have felt in the wilderness when He was tested by Satan.

After a year of battling with depression, the Letters "Death to Depression" (ML #3464) came out, which I held on to. It began to dawn on me that this was not a victory I could win in my own strength—only the Lord could do it. I started memorizing keys on trusting in the Lord, and reading more Word on letting go and letting God. I told the Lord to take care of His property and that I would serve Him no matter what. I would continue witnessing, whether I was healed or not. Slowly but surely, the battles lessened as I gained my victory day by day. It took another six months before I won a complete victory, but I sure learned a lot about fighting the Enemy and his demons. After this year-and-a-half-long battle for the victory, I asked my RSs if I could be FM, as I felt that this would take some of the pressure off and give me time to "catch my breath."

My wife and I became FM, and through it we experienced something that we never knew about. Although we've been serving the Lord in the Family for nearly 30 years and have many good friends in many countries, once we were FM, some FD brethren, even some we had known and worked with for years, started treating us like failures and avoiding us.

We didn't understand why, because we were the same people as a month ago. But their perception of us changed radically when we changed status. It was such a surprise and letdown to us, as we always felt that the FMers were still Family members, which they are. But some people didn't seem to think so.

The surprise went even further when we went on outreach, as we were still serving the Lord full time. We witnessed every day, morning and afternoon, lived by faith, homeschooled our child, followed the *Charter*, etc. But suddenly we did not have a "right" to any witnessing areas and some FDers treated us like we didn't exist. If they went on a road trip to a town, and we had no idea and would go to the same place, we would receive less than pleasant phone calls from them about it, because they felt we had no rights to it.

The Word talks a lot about not looking down on other categories of membership as "bad" places of service, only for "those who have flunked, or for losers." One quote in "Getting Stronger" says: "It is when people get hung up on labels and levels, and who is higher than whom and they look down on others, and feel they are more 'elite than thou' that they get caught up in a system, and they forget the simple love of Christ which is supposed to constrain us" (ML #3515:112).

I'm thrilled with the MM category, and I hope that we will truly live up to the requirements in the Word to make this level what it is meant to be. The new vision for the Family is to bring in new people to become a more united Family at all levels, so it is going to take every one at each level to bring this to pass. And only if the Family is working together in unity will the sheep see our love, unity, and light and be happy to join, whether as AM, FM, MM, or FD.

Since we have a needs list on our bulletin board that our friends can help with if they like, he studied it for a while and finally said, "Come to my house tomorrow, I am buying you a bicycle. You also mentioned you needed silverware for the kitchen. What exactly do you want and how many?" He bought us both the bicycle and the silverware and whenever we thank him for it he says, "It was only Jesus supplying your needs."

John continues to go personal witnessing with us every Friday afternoon, where we pass out tracts and talk with those we meet, and has started to ask how he can become a missionary as well.
