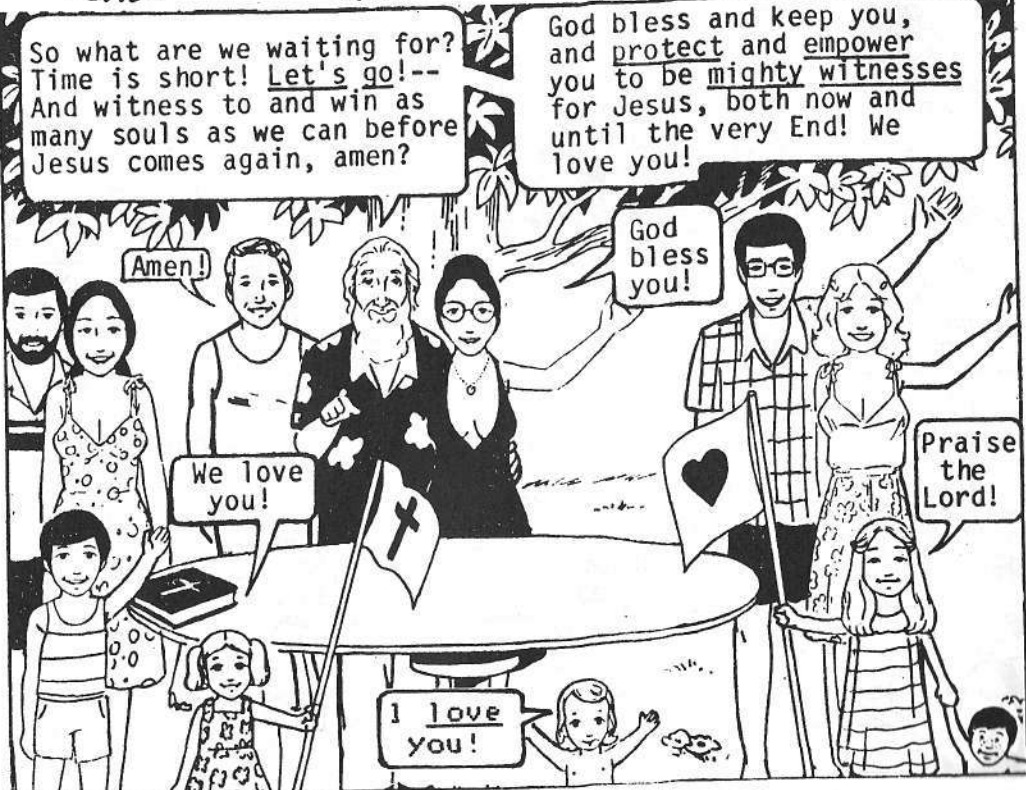

Good morning, brave pioneers!

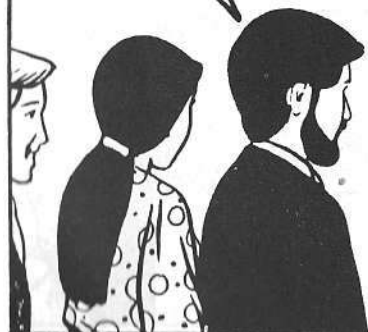
Good morning, Grandpa! Good morning, Mommy!

Daddy has our passports!



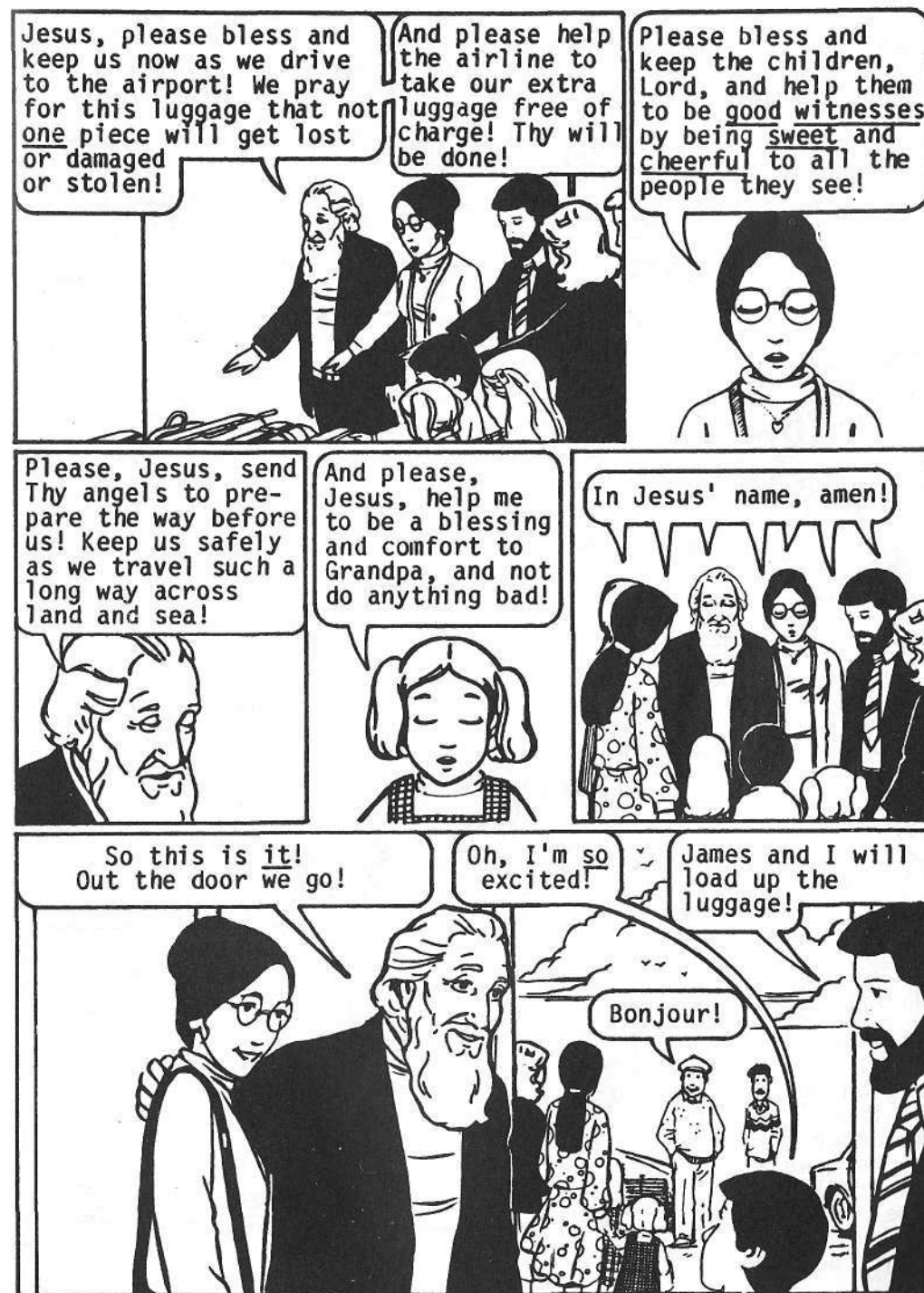
It's very good for the parents to look after the children's passports!

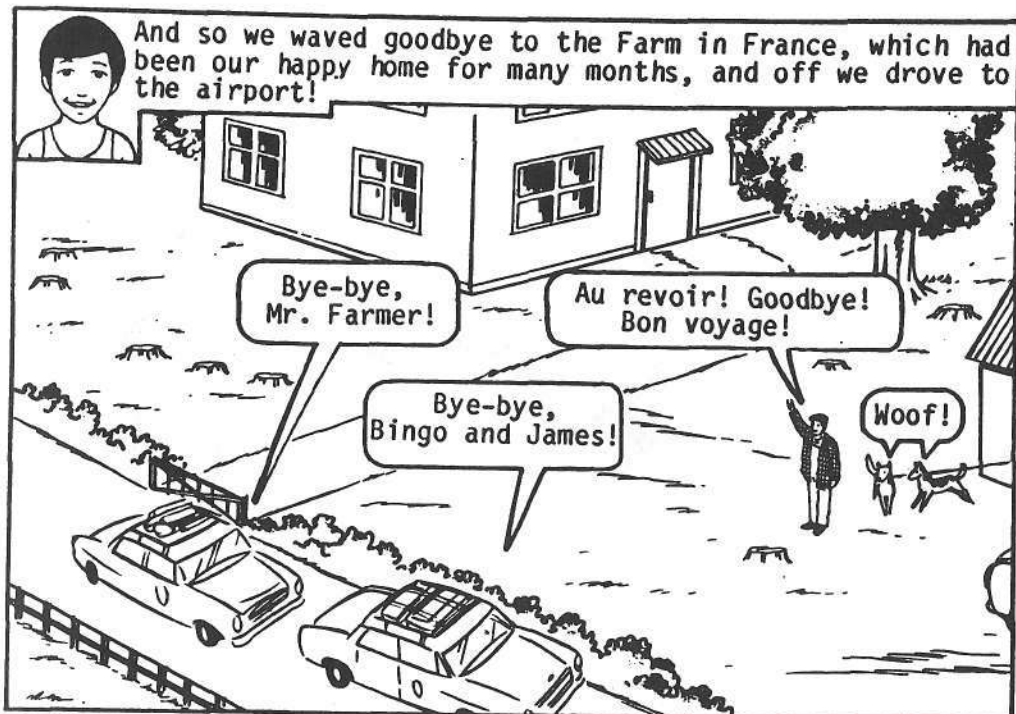
And please, everyone, be sure to keep your passport very safely, as it is one of your most valuable possessions!



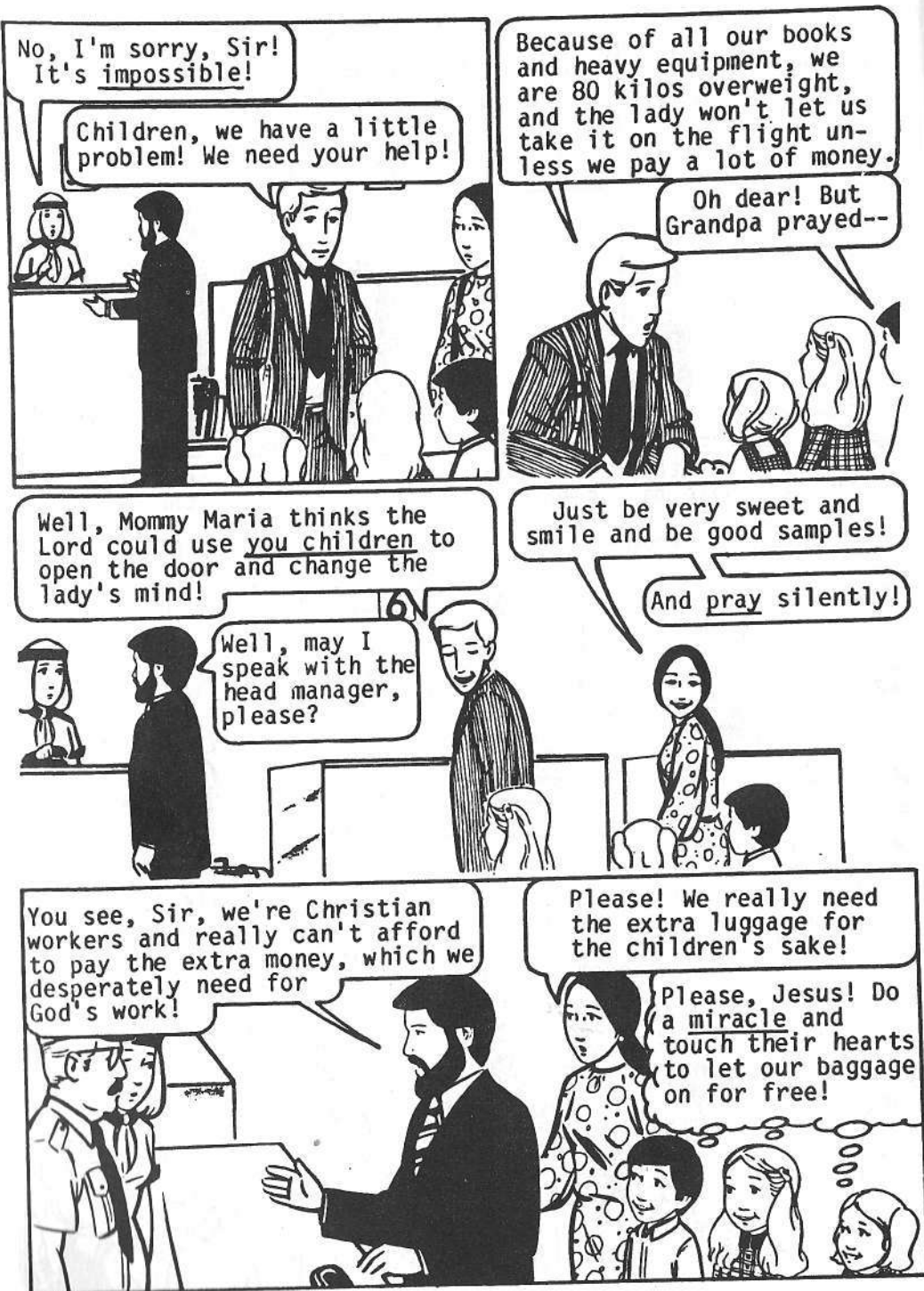
It is your passport to freedom to preach the Gospel!

During take-off it's very important to sit still and be quiet!--And pray!

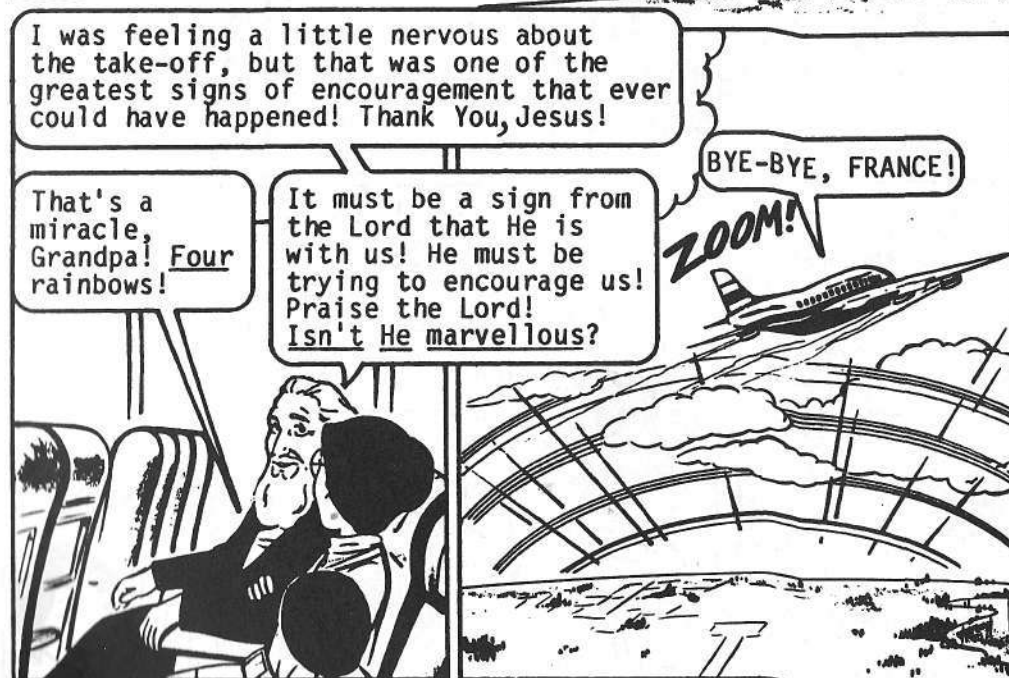
NO, SARA! WAIT!

Yes, Sir! That's a good tip!

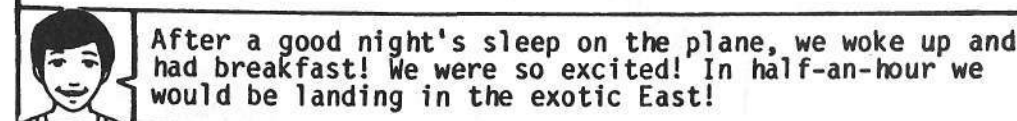
Let's hold hands in our seating groups and quietly pray for a safe take-off! When we're in public like this, we can pray with our eyes open!

We hope you enjoyed your flight!

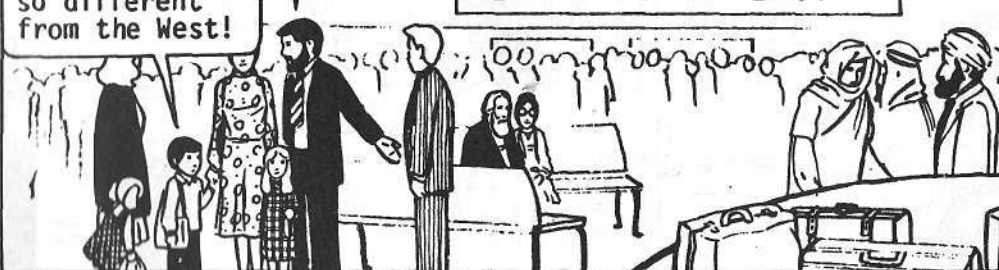
Yes, thank you! God bless you for taking such good care of us!

All our luggage arrived safely and in perfect shape!

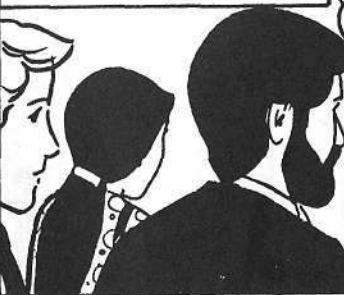


That's wonderful!

Thank You Jesus for answering our prayers!



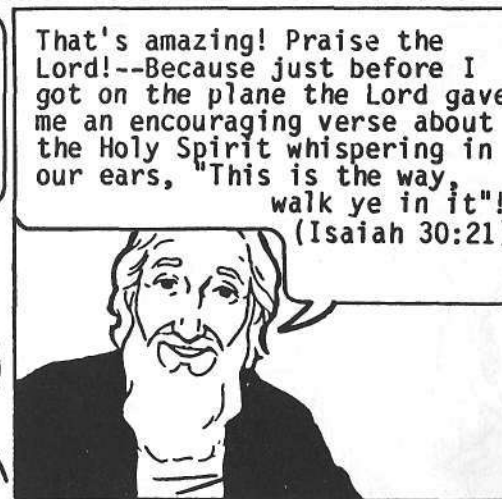
The next great event was passing through customs!

It's for when I need to tinkle!



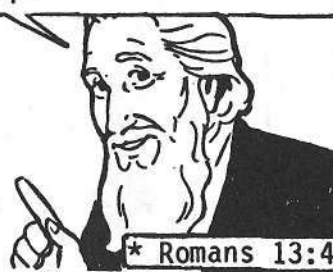
Okay, er, good! Thank you!

Door handles in public places are always very dirty!

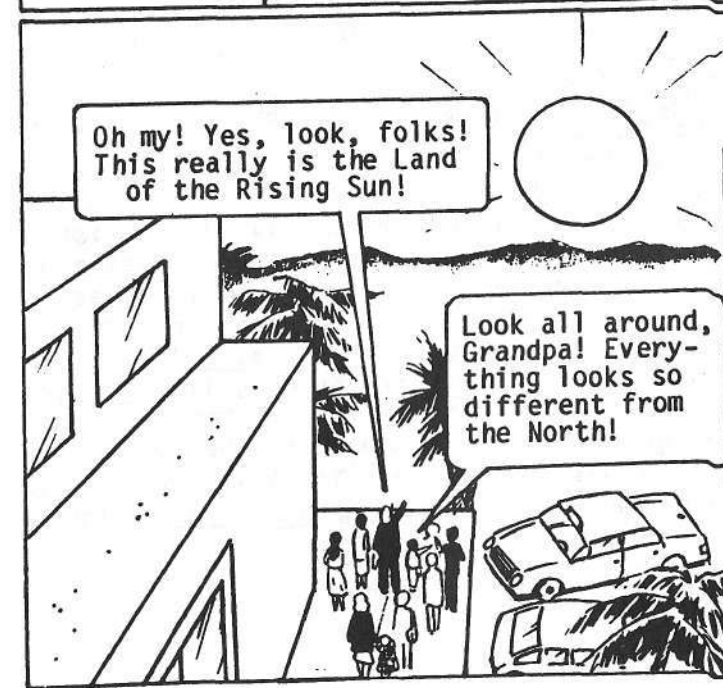
Good idea!



LOOK, GRANDPA! THE BIG RED SUN!



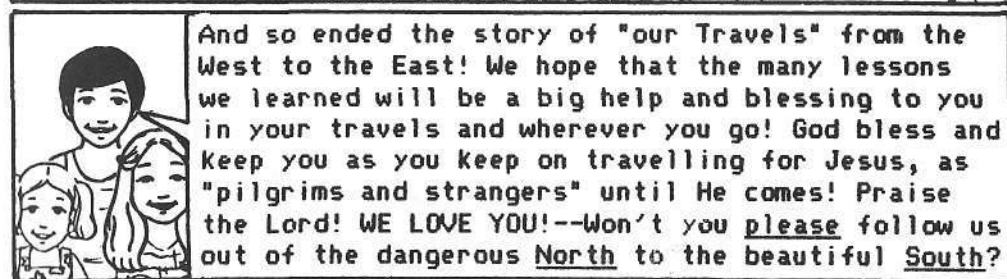
Oh my! Yes, look, folks! This really is the Land of the Rising Sun!
