

33. MARIA SUGGESTED WE HAVE PLENTY OF PACIFIERS ON HAND and keep them sterilized and stored in covered sterilized jars, so that as soon as one became soiled we always had a clean one on hand. Pacifiers that come with a tight-fitting cover are very convenient and much more sanitary.

34. THE LOUDEST DAVIDITO WOULD GET WAS DURING HIS BATH. He would whoop like an Indian as soon as you took his tee-shirt off and continue until the bath was finished, so furious, he'd turn as bright red as his Spanish blood!

35. AFTER USING THE BATHINGETTE, we wiped and dried it out, then sprayed it with a disinfectant so it wouldn't get moldy and sour-smelling inside. Mommy always made sure the room was well-heated before we even started the bath.

38. DAVIDITO SEEMED TO HAVE SUCH AN APPETITE, that when he was only 19 days old they suggested we feed him a little cereal from a bottle. We thought, however, if continued that, it might cut down his milk intake, so he was over two months old when we began the cereal again.

39. MOTHER EVE LOOKED AFTER HIM A FEW TIMES when Lucy had to do shopping or errands, and Lydia was always a tremendous help with her suggestions and care for him. During Maria's post-natal rest, Daddy sometimes needed the nannies' loving care too! Hallelujah! Stephen came in handy playing the guitar to Davidito for inspiration. But Davidito is more sensitive when even a few extra people are around, and never seems to rest as well.

43. MOOMY SAYS SHE PREFERS THINGS TO BE MADE AT HOME on the sewing machine rather than buying everything because it is so much cheaper and you can have what you want, if you have time and a good seamstress.

44. SHE HAD HER MATERNITY CLOTHES MADE by a local seamstress who they wanted to help out with work, and we even looked into making baby clothes, as well as robes, curtains, blankets and sheets on the machine.

45. DADDY FOUND A REAL NICE WASHING MACHINE on sale and made sure to explain to all of us exactly how to use it and how to change the filter. He believes in everyone reading the instruction booklet before using any type of equipment. That way we don't break things and ruin things the Lord has given us.
