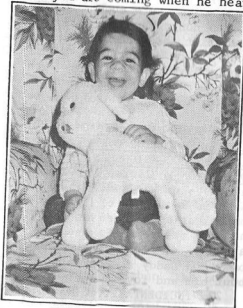


INTERCOM MONITORS IS A VERY HELPFUL AID FOR PARENTS TO HAVE IN THE HOME. The long wire type is less expensive than the wireless type you plug in, and you can buy them in some electrical or housing stores.

Then she can hear very clearly when the child wakes up and immediately go to him. They are especially helpful in a large house or two-story Home so that the parents do not have to sit listening for the child in the bedroom and miss devotions, meals or fellowship.

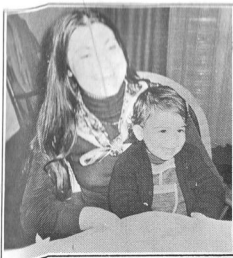
your familiar voice. Isn't that a nicer way to wake up?

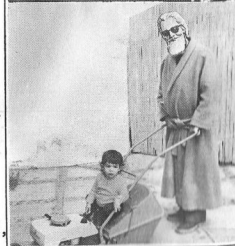
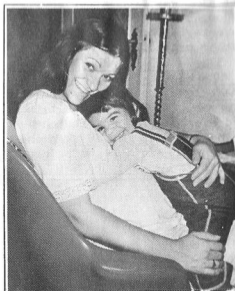
