things to put into a little sack that he carried with him. Right away he began pointing out plants, trees, rocks and bugs. He learned how to pick flowers from the bottom of the stem very carefully, and among other things, he spotted a worm that he scooped up on a leaf to carry home in his little sack.

23. ON OUR WALK WE SAW FOUR
POOR LITTLE RAGGED GIRLS walking our way and they stopped to stare at us. Davidito pointed to the

holes in their shoes. I told the girls that Jesus loved them and I suggested Davidito blow them a kiss for a little witness.
