"MOVE TO MADEIRA"--2 Yrs. 2 Mos. Old--By Sara Davidito. DFO-S-38 -- Chapter 41 of "Davidito". March, 1977.

1. DAVIDITO OFTEN HIDES BE-HIND THE LIVING ROOM FURNITURE. He gathers together all his toys to play with by himself.

2. HE INSISTS ON CRACKING HIS OWN EGGS AT BREAKFAST. Rather than squeezing them in one hand like he used to, he cracks the egg on the side of the pan, then opens them properly, right into the frying pan! He's been a very good, obedient boy about keeping very quiet in the house while others are working or resting.

3. AT MEALTIMES HE GIVES HIM-SELF A WHOLE SERMON when he doesn't eat his dinner: "No finish 'dinney' -- no snack! No plapla ('platano', or banana), no apple juice, no yo yo (yoghourt). no cake, no!"

4. DAVIDITO POINTS OUT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A TRICYCLE AND A BICYCLE, and can ride a friend's tricycle backwards and forwards a little bit. He also points out a poodle dog or a German Shepherd dog when out on walks.



5. TIME WITH MOMMY AND DADDY: REREAD THE BEAUTIFUL "PROPHECY FOR DAVIDITO", ML no. 619, for the Lord's very timely, sobering







message about the importance of teaching the words of our Father to all of our worldwide Family children!

6. AFTER A FEW VERY HECTIC AND BUSY WEEKS, INCLUDING COURT ISSUES, WITH THE ONSLAUGHT OF PER-MORNING FLIGHT, and because his SECUTION there in Tenerife, Mommy normal bedtime is about 10:00 and Daddy left the island with Alfred for a rest. The night before the morning they left, Davidito seemed to sense they were leaving, and demanded to be with Mommy to read to him before bedtime.





7. THEN, FOR THE FIRST TIME EVER, HE AND I WERE LEFT WITHOUT MOMMY, DADDY AND ALFRED. Davidito seemed to take the change fairly well, but by the end of the week

became much more nervous and anxious to see them again. Then we soon got the message to join Mommy and Daddy in a new location. 8. DAVIDITO HAD TO GET TO BED
