Even when Mommy & Daddy go down stairs together, Daddy goes first ahead of Mommy, & she rests her hand on his shoulder so not to fall & to be extra cautious. 3. MOMMY REMINDS DAVID, "PRAY BEFORE PLAY", so that he'll know how to prevent bumping his head &
