Here is a list of several important Bible characters, with references to parts of the Bible that give their biographies. Not every reference about each character is given; but enough is given for you to read the most important parts of his or her life story.

ABRAHAM: Genesis 11-25

JACOB: Genesis 25-35; 37: 42-49 JOSEPH: Genesis 37: 39-50.

Moses: Exodus 1-20; 24; 31-35; Numbers 10-14; 16-17; 20-21;

25; 27; Deuteronomy 31; 34. JOSHUA: The entire book of Joshua.

GIDEON: Judges 6-8 SAMSON: Judges 13-16.

RUTH: The entire book of Ruth. SAMUEL: 1 Samuel 1-13; 15-16; 19; 25.

DAVID: | Samuel 16-31; the book of 2 Samuel; 1 Kings 1-2. SOLOMON: 1 Kings 1-11.

ELUAH: 1 Kings 17-19; 21; 2 Kings 1-2. ELISHA: 1 Kings 19; 2 Kings 2-9; 13.

ISAIAH: Isaiah 6-8; 20; 36-39.

JEREMIAH: Jeremiah 1; 7; LL; 13; 16-22; 24-29; 32-44. Daniel 1-2; 4-6.

ESTHER: The entire book of Esther. NEHEMIAH: The entire book of Nehemiah.

JESUS: The entire books of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John, PETER: The entire book of Mark; Matthew 4; 16-18; Luke 5; 22; John 1; 13; 18-21; Acts 1-12; 15.

PAUL: Acts 7-9; 11-28; 2 Corinthians 11; Galatians 1-2.
