MAKE A BIBLE COURSE NOTEBOOK!

16. BOTH CHILDREN ENJOY ADDING TO THEIR OWN LINED NOTEBOOK, of about 80-100 pages, whatever writing or art activity our Bible class may offer! To help review or reinforce the lesson, we make application or comprehension exercises with reading & writing: fill-in-the-blanks, multiple choice, crossword puzzles, or simply for example, "Draw a picture of Isaac & Rebekah's family" (which could include the twin boys, blind Isaac, red hairy Esau the hunter, tent life, etc.). We used the picture each child drew on construction paper of the Garden of Eden to cover their notebooks, & labeled the front cover. "Don't Let Sin In!"

- SOLOMON: 1 Kings 1-11.
- ELIJAH: 1 Kings 17-19; 21; 2 Kings 1-2.
- ELISHA: 1 Kings 19; 2 Kings 2-9; 13.
- ISAIAH: Isaiah 6-8; 20; 36-39.
- JEREMIAH: Jeremiah 1; 7; 11; 13; 16-22; 24-29; 32-44.
- DANIEL: Daniel 1-2; 4-6.
- ESTHER: The entire book of Esther.
- NEHEMIAH: The entire book of Nehemiah.
- JESUS: The entire books of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.
- PETER: The entire book of Mark; Matthew 4; 16-18; Luke 5; 22; John 1; 13; 18-21; Acts 1-12; 15.
- PAUL: Act 7-9; 11-28; 2 Corinthians 11; Galatians 1-2.
