23. THE KEY TO MEMORY IS REPETITION -- REPETITION IS THE LAW OF MEMORY! The children have learned that "As you pour out. He'll pour in & you can never outpour Him", so verbally quoting their verses to edify others helps to lock the Word away in their hearts! As long as they hear the verse repeated, many, many times throughout the day, as well as read the verse oftentimes throughout the learning period, they not only hear it & see it often, but have the encouragement of learning it together along with you & you've avoided the drilling or testing frustration such as memory work can be to many little children! We like to try at least to make a little poem or song to memory verses, or if nothing else, simply tap out the rhythm of the verse on the table as we say the verse, to give it at least a little more rhythmical enjoyable pattern to remember it by. This is the beginning building-block, by the way,
