From Zimran & Mercy: U.S.A. Calorie Count & Water Needed for Dried Foods

From Emmanuel & Hannah: WE FOUND OUT THE APPROXIMATE CALORIE CONTENTS of the Rainy Day Dehydrated foods we bought. It works out to only about 750 calories per day per person for the actual food itself. This shows how important it is to supplement this food with added grains, honey & milk powder, as the dehydrated food alone would provide only about half of the minimum of what a person would need—less than half if any work is to be done.

WHEN WE ASKED HOW TO RECONSTITUTE THE DEHYDRATED FOOD we were told it could be prepared in 2 parts water to 1 part food. But in a survival situation they said 1 to 1 would be plenty. This means that each standard unit would need a total of about 140 liters of water at the 1 to 1 ratio,

or about .7 liter per day.

ON THE SUBJECT OF STORING WATER, we are using the method suggested by Dave in the Handyman Tips in Mag. 10. In there he suggests getting large plastic garbage cans with heavy duty garbage bags & then storing water in these.

AFTER LOOKING INTO DIFFERENT METHODS, we decided this would be best for us as, 1. it was the cheapest way, garbage cans with lids being much cheaper than "jerry cans", 2. simpler & quicker & safer to fill than trying to collect & use a bunch of glass juice jars. 3. When we move, these cans are quite lightweight & stack fairly compactly inside each other for easy shipment or economical replacement at our new location.

The Gypsy Caravan Life Works!

IT DIDN'T SEEM POSSIBLE IN MODERN TIMES that a family with 5 children, 1 of them a newborn, could live under these conditions. The caravan was not spacious & luxurious as many I had seen, but was only 25 feet, tho' comfortable & warm.

IN FACT, IT WAS GETTING A LITTLE CROWDED so they had put up a large tent for storage & to accommodate an extra couple who were in transit waiting to take a boat to a distant land. Yet I had done the same thing when I lived in a caravan, always finding a place on an old couch or bed under the awning for a passing friend who needed a place to stay.

WE WERE LIKE THIS FAMILY WHO WERE SO READY TO SHARE what they had & thankful for the extra fellowship & help around the camp. The extra people could lend a

helping hand cooking, washing dishes & caring for the children. It didn't matter that it took extra food to feed them, because they had plenty of fresh fruits & vegetables which they provisioned from the outdoor market in the city.

I HAD ALMOST FORGOTTEN IT WAS POSSIBLE TO LIVE IN SUCH A SMALL SPACE! But their small caravan was very well-organized with double bunk beds in the back & lots of shelf space. There was even a small room for washing up & the toilet (which had to be emptied once a day in the wooded area nearby where they had dug a deep hole for that purpose).

THE MOTHER SAID SHE FOUND IT QUITE POSSIBLE TO WASH THE CLOTHES IN COLD WATER in her small portable washing machine, since she had found the right soap powder & used a little bleach & wore gloves. This was a revolution to me as I never thought it possible to do a family wash in cold water. But the children's clothes looked very clean & neat as they dressed up to go out singing or played around the camp.

THE CHILDREN LIKED TO CUT UP THE VEGETABLES & hang up the laundry & were used to washing dishes & helping with the daily chores. Of course, it was more fun to do any kind of work outside under the trees!

FOR A FEW DAYS WE OBSERVED THIS LITTLE FAMILY as we lived in another caravan where we were able to enjoy the beauties of God's creation with them. We learned that the caravan, bought 2nd-hand in France 3 years ago, had undergone many changes in order to make more living area & floor space for the children to work & play. They had also built a small table with children's chairs for the 2 younger chil-

dren to eat at or do schoolwork. IT WAS ON THE MISSION FIELD IN A POOR COUNTRY that they were able to fix up the caravan. Here, where life moves slowly, a sweet tailor was happy to sew without charge new vinyl seat covers for the 2 long livingroom benches. The material, so easy to sponge down after meals, had been donated by kind friends.

THEY DESCRIBED HOW MANY OF THE MATERIALS WERE MYSTERIOUSLY FOUND OR GIVEN by friends, including the washing machine, light fixtures, rugs & even new tires for the caravan & car to keep this little family rolling along for Jesus. One time they were so surprised when an unsuspecting young man they had met while singing in a rather 2nd-class restaurant took the couple into a tire shop & bought them 2 brand new tires for the car, insisting to the shopkeeper that "these people travel to foreign countries & they need the best tires available!" I too have many sweet memories of the wonderful people who helped us to be mobile during many years of exciting travel & witnessing experiences with my own children.

3 SMALL TIPS: 1) To save water: Place 1 or 2 drops of liquid body soap in the wash-up bowl rather than using hand soap. It leaves a fragrant scent on your hands & the water does not become soapy & lasts longer. 2) To save gas: Whenever water is heated for dishes etc., heat a bit extra & store in a thermos. When you want to wash the children's faces or fix a warm drink, your hot water is ready. 3) If you have a fitted sheet for a single bed & want to convert it to a double bed sheet, sew a panel of similar material down the middle.—You'll still have the 4 fitted corners! ■
