Try Making a Weekly Schedule!

From Heidi Starbright: N. Eur.: I HAVE FOUND THAT SITTING DOWN ONCE A WEEK & writing out a weekly devotions & schooltime schedule for my 2 year old daughter is a tremendous help in filling her educational needs every day.

ONCE A WEEK I FIND TIME TO GO OFF FOR A COUPLE OF HOURS to read & study the Davidito Letters & other childcare material for counsel & suggestions, & then I make a schedule in my notebook for each day of the week.

FOR INSTANCE, HERE'S THIS MONDAY'S SCHEDULE: Devotions: Read "Merlin's Hat", point out from the Letter the lesson on Witnessing & memorize Mark 16:15. Make a Merlin's hat by rolling a large piece of paper into the shape of a cone & cut out different kinds of shapes from the hat. Put that hat on the floor & let a flashlight shine thru' the holes. Sing "This Little Light of Mine". Schooltime: Scoop peas into little jars. Make a spotlight to review colours & learn about traffic. Cut the lights from coloured paper & let Nina glue them to the right spot on the traffic signal. Reading: Learn the word

hat. Practise drawing lines & circles on the chalkboard. Grouping: Find things that are transparent. Art: Make a tree by gluing evergreen needles on the outline of a tree you have drawn.

WITH THIS WEEKLY SCHEDULE, I can just follow it without having to strain myself for ideas during the precious teaching time. Of course, it can be varied according to the child's interest & any spur-of-the-moment ideas. Also I can just give the notebook to someone else who doesn't usually teach school & they'll know exactly what to do. Having someone else teach every once in a while is really good 'cause the kids need & enjoy variety as well as the mother. Happy learning fun!—Heidi.

Using Correspondence School!

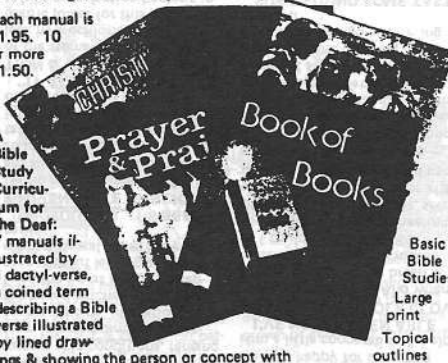
