TEACHER STARTS DRAMA CLUB TO FEED NEW BOTTLES!

From Gabriel & Jerusalem; Europe:

GBY: WE HOPE THAT THIS TESTIMONY WILL BE AN ENCOURAGEMENT to others who have an opportunity to work closer with the Catholics or even teach in their school systems.

I TEACH ENGLISH TO APPROXIMATELY 450 GIRLS in 12 different classes on 5 different grade levels. The vast majority are on a high school level, & the Muns are quite liberal, many of whom are young & don't even wear habits. They are generally very interested in the girls' spiritual condition, their prayer life, etc. And before all my classes we sing the "Lord's Prayer" in English which rings out for all to hear, a real testimony!

MUSIC IS A REAL WITNESSING TOOL that turns the girls' keys & really opens wide the door to guide & form their lives. They love to listen to the MWN tapes!

READING TO A CLASS FROM A POPULAR MAGAZINE ABOUT BOB DYLAN'S BORN AGAIN EXPERIENCE opened the door to read John 3:1-8 to explain his conversion. This along with Rev. 3:20 enabled me to lead many to the Lord! PHN! The girls beg me for music, so I keep feeding them the latest songs from MWN.

ALSO, BEING IN A CATHOLIC SCHOOL, I can often take a Bible right off the shelf & give them a brief Matthew 24 class, etc. directly out of the Word. In two of my classes of older girls, their questions were so sheepy that I carried it right on into Revelation & the A.C. & the last seven years!

OF COURSE NO LETTERS ARE A CONSTANT SOURCE OF SPIRITUAL FOOD & EXCITING TEACHING IDEAS. The flannelgraph

helped me lead many of my classes of younger girls to the Lord. After doing the flannelgraph for the class, I ask them several questions like: "Just as the King looked down from his window at the people in His kingdom, do you think God looks down on us to see if we do good or bad things?" (They answer yes)

THEN I ASK THEM QUESTIONS, instructing them to raise their hands if they agree. For example: "How many of you are bad sometimes & need to ask Jesus to forgive you?" & "How many of you

heart He could help you to be better & have more love for others?"

AS THEY ALWAYS RAISE THEIR HANDS IN AGREEMENT TO THESE QUESTIONS, I then cite them clearly Rev. 3:20 & we talk about it & where the door is, etc. Then I ask them the final question: "As Jesus is knocking at the door to your hearts, how many want to let Him in, to be your friend forever, accepting Him as your Saviour?" TYJ! It's so encouraging to see their hands shoot up, receiving the Lord into their hearts! And thank God for Dad's letter, "Your 2-Year-Old Can Receive Jesus", which gave me the faith for this method in my Selah situation.

LATER, I GOT TO THINKING THAT THE GIRLS ARE LEARNING LOTS OF ENGLISH, they are well-fed spiritually, they have the Lord in their hearts, but I felt that I could do more. Well, the Lord didn't take long in answering my plea. Shortly afterward in a teachers' meeting the director was mentioning that the school lacked some sort of cultural program. The greatest need seemed to be a Dramatics Club to put on plays & promote creativity among the girls.

OTHER TEACHERS SPOKE OF HOW THE GIRLS HAD MANY COMPLEXES & FEARS ABOUT ACTING naturally in front of others, so they really supported the drama club idea. What an open door! By faith I told them of my acting experience & desire for something new & to everyone's surprise, I was instantly given the job!

WELL, THAT WAS ABOUT 4 OR 5 MONTHS AGO. As it was totally voluntary, only girls with a real interest came. Soon I had a small

willing new bottles. **THE FIRST CLASSES WE SPENT GETTING OUT OF OURSELVES DOING CHARADES & acting out little scenes in pantomime from Family skits.** For the first play, I combined ideas from a couple of Family skits to make a beautiful pantomime based on the fight between good & evil in a modern rat-race society.

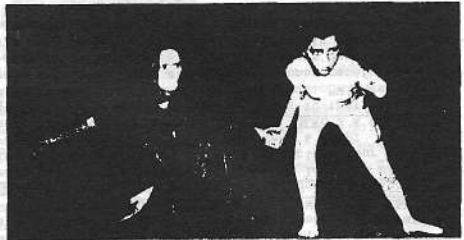
IT REALLY MADE EPHESIANS 6:12 CLEAR, that there is a spiritual warfare for our souls, & of course in the end Love conquers all! The play ends when even the evil character changes heart & the whole cast sings the song "Change the World!" PTL!

THE GIRLS, FROM 13 TO 17 YEARS OLD, REALLY PUT THEIR HEARTS INTO IT, & using simple props, tight, sound effects on the guitar, & even the stage lights all help to give it a special touch. We also made up a classy program to hand out at the door. Inside the program we put not only the cast names & credits, but also a page-full of Bible verses & Mo quotes complementary to the play. PTL! I almost forgot to mention that the title of the play is "The Darkest Moment Is Just Before Dawn!"

WELL, PRAISE THE LORD, WE'VE NOW PUT ON THE PLAY 5 TIMES, reaching over 1,500 people in four different schools, including an orphanage-reformatory. The last time we did the play a university professor saw it, & now he wants us to do it at the university.

THEY WANT TO ARRANGE A CONFERENCE RIGHT BEFORE THE PLAY dealing with the problems of the youth such as drugs & vice, & then put on the play as the solution! TYJ! God's love is the answer to everything!

EVERY DAY ANOTHER EXCITING WITNESSING OPPORTUNITY OPENS! We're now working on

our second play which is a longer version of "Tommy", & since we are writing the script ourselves, it's full of Mo quotes, Bible verses & several Family songs!

THE MOST FRUITFUL THING ABOUT THIS WHOLE THEATRE EXPERIENCE HAS BEEN MY PERSONAL CONTACT & INFLUENCE on my students in a friendlier "out of the classroom" situation. Before most of the rehearsals & every time we have put on the play, we've been holding hands & praying, & the Lord has really been answering our prayers. The girls have learned so many

WITNESSING THRU TEACHING WHEN OTHER DOORS CLOSED!

From Ahlai Gospel; S. America:

WE WANT TO SHARE SOME EXPERIENCES WE HAD IN ENGLISH TEACHING in Latin America with hopes that it might help others. First of all, for it to bear fruit & to expect the right doors to open, you have to know that it's the Lord's will & be sure that that's the most you could be doing with your time on the field for Him.

FOR EXAMPLE, 2 years ago we were under persecution & almost had to leave this country. But the Lord showed us to try teaching English temporarily, & we learned a lot as well as using it as an opportunity to witness.

IN GETTING THE JOB I DID NOT COME ON AS A MISSIONARY, but God's Spirit is hard to hide & everyone notices something different about you. The director of the English school soon became a real friend, the co-signer on our house, & even chipped in furniture, etc.

AFTER A 2-WEEK TRAINING SESSION & AN EXPERIMENTAL CONVERSATION CLASS, I got to choose my own hours, which were usually 2 hours in the afternoon when the kids napped. These couple of hours each day conveniently paid our rent monthly on a nice home with a phone & helped with tithing on our provisioned goods. This also led to other opportunities, such as interpreting, translating, etc. And when Olynpas & Beara came here the director even asked us all to read the textbook on tape; that was a lot of fun & helped a lot financially.

THE MOST INCREDIBLE PART OF THIS WHOLE EXPERIENCE WAS THE TESTIMONY & OUTREACH it was to new bottles & the children of the city fathers

ily songs & Mo Lion Readers & simple Komix. The director loved it & invited me to attend a statewide seminar at the university on "What Children Should Read". After 2 hours of jargon & no answers, they opened up the floor to discussions.

ENCOURAGED BY THE DIRECTOR TO SHARE WHAT WAS ON MY HEART (she was really won over by our kids' sample), I was the 1st to shoot up my hand. They called me to the mike, & I was able to share for about 10 minutes, giving the whole message of "You Are What You Read" & "Students Stand Up", which I had read the night before. I also told them not to underestimate the importance of the parents' & teachers' own sample of reading good, lasting material such as the Bible, & I shared about early Christian training starting from birth.

MANY WANTED TO TRANSLATE THE Mo Lion Readers that I presented & asked for copies of the True Komix. I gave away all the TKs that I had & sent out more later. This seminar was attended by the principals & many educators of every school in the state, & many told us afterward that our (Dad's) words changed the whole tone (spirit) of the convention. Hallelujah! Thank God for the MWNs! Many of the teachers wanted to follow this advice in their schools! (Hail! TYJ! He works!)
