

"GODAHLI'S MAGIC LAMP", paragraph 28 says: "We had just been shocked by the news of Nasser's sudden death & were wondering why he had died at this particularly pregnant hour in World affairs, & we were pondering this while walking slowly down a darkened Paris street still asking God why, when suddenly & very unexpectedly the Spirit spoke: 'That last Wicked One might be revealed.' -2 Th.2:1-12.

"And so shall it be even as I have said, there shall yet arise one more King out of Egypt, & after him shall come he whose coming is after the working of Satan." Well, that doesn't forebode very good for whatever the next guy's going to be! How would you interpret that? Who was Sadat? It sounds like Sadat was the one more king after him, then after him this other guy. In "The Pied Piper Prophecy" in 1971, paragraphs 35-38:

"Maria: What do you think about Godaahl? MO: He prepares the way for the King of Egypt." "For the King of Egypt"—now that must be really the Antichrist, hmm? That's what it sounds like. Prophecy is not always easy to understand & interpret, but obviously he certainly wasn't preparing the way for Sadat. He was doing everything he could to prepare a way to get rid of him!

Now how can that happen when all the **rest** of the countries & even the **Arab** countries mentioned there are all on the side of the **Antichrist**? I just sort of sighed a sigh of relief, well, PTL, things are really movin' along, Lord! There's one more step in the right direction, there's one more obstacle out of the way. They keep talking about obstacles of peace, Sadat was one more obstacle to war that God had to get rid of, because the war's got to come to punish the World for its sins. It's going to come.

Well, we're one step, one man closer to the fire tonight! One more dam has broken, one more wall of protection has tumbled, one more man is out of the way that stood between this World & God's judge & mentor, & one step closer to the End! PTL! Maybe that means when he reveals himself to the World & his true character & nature. It sounds like then he'll be revealed in his true nature & what he's really up to. That Scripture in 2 Th.2 sounds to me, in fact, very specifically more like when he takes over & sets up his idol & sits in the Temple of God saying that he is God, right? "Then shall that man of sin be revealed"—The Antichrist!



I too have always wished I'd gotten to know you two better, but then there are the Letters which are so revealing of the most important facets of your persons: your Love which has been clearly demonstrated by their ability to raise support funds at home. I'm inspired to write you by the recent reading of "Border Bases" and other publications. In "ED" you have so succinctly developed a very wise idea whose time has definitely come—at least down here in this part of the world. If Latin America is indeed the Continent of Hope, and if The Lord is leading us down here to be His bastion, His Gideon's Band and front line, this projected Family immigration must be orderly, prayerful, and available to those whose faith has been clearly demonstrated by their ability to raise support funds at home. "A wise king scattereth" the undeserving and weak as well as the wicked.

I was surprised, however, by the absence of Copenhagen and Rose as European border bases. From experience I recollect both as being good capitals where to obtain cheap, long-haul tickets to South America and Southeast Asia alike. But perhaps there are powerful reasons to exclude them. (Interesting!) As regards Latin America, I would like to respectfully submit some suggestions. Panama may serve as a useful special border base for a couple of reasons: many ships coming from Europe, North America and the Far East stop there; and many of the cut-rate airlines plying the US/South America route (like Ecuatorian and Lloyd Aero Boliviana) stop there. (Sounds good!)

In addition, Panama is virtually a free port where otherwise-expensive equipment may be obtained before heading on. As a field it is probably saturated and/or uninviting, so it would serve solely as a Border Base for the South American continent as a whole. (A possibility.)

I didn't fully understand how Valparaiso qualified as a BB instead of Santiago. Its situation is not the same as Guayaquil's which receives at least half of Ecuador's international flights because it is that country's international banking and trade center besides being its main port. Valparaiso is Chile's main seaport and as such it's important but it's a good two hour drive from the Santiago airport. (Where would you suggest?)

Concerning cash funds for your first three months, I heartily agree with the \$2000 minimum—for a family of no more than 4, however. And this amount may prove to be messy in places like Caracas and Buenos Aires. (Right?)

It may be good to point out to those heading by air for Buenos Aires that an on-going ticket to Montevideo usually adds little or nothing to their total plane fare if they buy it all together. In other words, if they're leaving, say, from New York, they need to buy a ticket NY-Buenos Aires-Montevideo. This will enable them to fly there for their first visa renewal almost for free. (Amen!)

Another practical idea—again, if you're flying to B.A. from somewhere like the US or Europe is to purchase your ticket all the way to another point in Argentine territory, such as Mendoza, CORDoba or Bariloche. This will add little or nothing to the price of a ticket ending in Buenos Aires. (For example, from San Juan the one-way fare is \$512 to B.A., and there's absolutely no additional charge if your destination point is Mendoza or CORDoba, although you're allowed to stopover in B.A. as long as you want. To Bariloche there is a \$153 surcharge) (Good idea!)

This arrangement, of course, doesn't afford them a free trip out of the country for visa renewal, but it does give them a longdistance on-going ticket to the huge Argentine country for nothing. This would be especially attractive to those considering settling in either the vineyard-rich Mendoza area, with a population of over a million and an hour-and-a-half jet flight away from S.A., or the Alpine-like Bariloche region, which is nearly three hours away.

Both Mendoza and Bariloche, incidentally, are a short train or bus ride away from visa renewal at the Chilean border. And you don't have to go too far up river to reach Paraguay from Cordoba. So, I would strongly suggest getting your travel agent or airline ticket office to extend your ticket to those cities free of charge. (Amen! Let's away from sky-high prices of ~~far~~ impossible routes!)

None of the above is, of course, available to those flying there on charter flights or on any other one-airline deals where you may not switch airlines after you buy your ticket, unless it's on Aerolineas Argentinas who also fly the domestic routes in Argentina.

Well, PTL, this started as a short love note and, as I'm prone to do, I've extended it into a verbose letter. Hope some of it is useful, though. (Very!)
