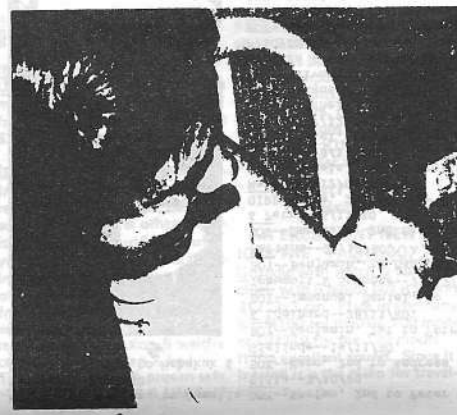

DAD THE BACK-SEAT DRIVER!
--Driving Tips & Lessons Learned While Driving with Dad!--By James Penn

1. **DRIVING WITH DAD IS LIKE GETTING FREE DRIVING LESSONS** from one of the best teachers in the world. Here again, as in all the other aspects of his household, he is very faithfully concerned with the little details. Here are some of the tips that we have picked up in our day-to-day driving here which have not already been covered in the various Letters & classes already published.

2. **THE ONE THING DAD ALWAYS EMPHASISES** to those of us who drive is the extreme importance of desperate prayer & relying utterly on the Lord while driving.--Praying without ceasing! He does not want any of us to become one of the thousands that are killed on the highways each year, & he is also concerned that due to our highly sensitive security situation here that we have not even the slightest accident, scrape, or traffic ticket, as we certainly can't afford the risk! So he makes sure that each of us knows it is very, very important to stay in desperate prayer while driving & to be very cautious.

3. **SO WHENEVER WE HAVE TO GO ANYWHERE WE FIRST OF ALL DECIDE WHETHER A TRIP WITH A VEHICLE IS ABSOLUTELY ESSENTIAL,**

or could we instead ride the bus, or even walk. When going out anywhere by whatever means, we always have before we leave, good united prayer, but especially desperate when we must drive a car, really asking the Lord to protect us & to keep all the parts of the car in good working order & keep us from other drivers. "You may not be a fool, but you sure can meet a lot of them!" he says.

4. **OF COURSE THE GENERAL POLICY CONCERNING THE USE OF THE CAR** is to never use a car when it is possible to take public transport. So unless there are more than two people going somewhere that it is possible to get to by public transportation, we always simply just take the public transport even if it takes a little longer, as it is just so much less worry & problems for everybody. The car is only used if we are going somewhere inaccessible to public transport or if we are getting things that are too heavy to take on the bus or train--or in the case of dire emergency.--Or too many passengers.

5. **ONE OF OUR DRIVERS RECENTLY HAD A SLIGHT ACCIDENT,** no one was hurt, TTL, & it wasn't our fault at all, but the Lord

used it to show us we were driving unnecessarily rather than using public transport, so we now arrange all our trips to town to coincide with the bus schedule & only use the vehicle for one weekly food shopping excursion.

6. **BEFORE WE GO ANYWHERE DAD ALWAYS MAKES SURE THE DRIVER HAS CHECKED THE OIL,** the battery & the water & he walks around the car often himself to check the tires to see if they are all OK. We also always make sure to warm the engine up for a few minutes before leaving, so as not to just drive off with a cold engine.

7. **WHENEVER WE ARE DRIVING IN A BUILT-UP AREA** or where there are pedestrians or children anywhere near the road he always asks us to drive very slowly. He said, "Even if they think you're a creep, you'd better creep". He likes us in general to plan ahead & not to have to make sudden or last minute swerves or turns.

8. **THE MAXIMUM SPEED AT WHICH YOU CAN SAFELY DRIVE** & still be more or less fully in control of the car is about 90 km. an hour (60 mph)--even on the superhighways. Above this speed even if you see something well in advance you are going so fast that it is physically impossible to stop your car & to avoid having an accident. So Dad believes that 90 km an hour (60 mph) should be the maximum speed at which anyone in our family drives. Above this is too hard to react in time if something should happen, because you are simply going so fast & it takes too long to stop & you are really not in control of your vehicle.

9. **ON SECONDARY ROADS HE LIKES TO DRIVE** no more than 60 kph (40 mph). Of course he does not believe in driving slower than the general flow of the traffic, but if the other people are really driving too fast he would rather pull over & let them all pass than to have a big parade going along behind him. He doesn't like tailgaters & doesn't like to be pressured by other cars when we are driving, so will often tell us to pull over & let them all pass. If there are two lanes going in one direction, he prefers to drive in the slow lane, as it's much safer & allows the speed demons to pass on the other.

10. **HE KEEPS A GOOD LOOK-OUT FOR US TO SEE IF THERE ARE ANY POT HOLES & ROUGH SPOTS** in the road, & always asks us to avoid them as these can be murder on the suspension & the tires of your car & can

even break your axle. Dad has pointed out that stones on hard paved roads can do a lot more damage to your tires than stones on dirt roads, as on the paved roads there is no give in the road, & it can inflict damage even if it doesn't cause a blow-out right away.

11. **DAD'S ALSO VERY CONCERNED THAT ALL THE CAR PAPERS ARE IN ORDER** & the insurance paid up to date & sees to it that checking on this is the specific responsibility of someone in the house. He likes to know himself exactly what the insurance policy covers & generally feels that full coverage is much too high & quite an unnecessary expense. He has mentioned to us that he feels for the Family it would generally be the best policy to get only required liability insurance, as studies conducted by various companies which have fleets of vehicles have shown it is often cheaper to just get the minimum insurance & pay for the occasional dent etc, than to pay high rates & never benefit from them. He says we should drive carefully & prayerfully & trust the Lord to keep us so we won't get into all sorts of accidents. So, as a rule, just get the liability insurance which is legally acceptable in each country & trust the Lord for His protection, the best insurance of all.

12. **DAD IS A FIRM BELIEVER IN KEEPING THE CAR IN GOOD APPEARANCE,** as it is a good testimony to those we meet. He has said that people will judge the way you look after other things by the way you look after your car.

13. **ONE THING THAT CAN REALLY TRANSFORM THE APPEARANCE OF A CAR** is an occasional wax job using a paste wax such as Johnson's, which is available in most countries for about \$5 a can. Once you have washed the car, simply apply the wax over the whole surface, really taking time to get in all the nooks & crannies that normally are missed in the wash. Then you rub it off & buff it with a dry rag. You will find that often the wax will take off at least as much dirt as the wash did & really transform the look of your car no matter how old it is. Of course this may take two or three hours & seem like extra work, but once it is done it only needs to be re-done about every two or three months.

14. **ALSO ONCE YOU HAVE WAXED THE CAR,** a quick wash will restore the original brilliance of the wax job. We have found

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
