Dear Family and friends!
God bless you all! We really love you and pray for you! Thank you so much for all your inspiring letters - they are truly like "cold waters to a thirsty soul"! (Pr. 25:25)

Well - here we are - in the land of smiles! And the Thais really are a smiling people - a very hospitable people! We are so thankful to be here, and excited by all the possibilities! But here we would like to share with you how the Lord got us out of Denmark by pure miracles:

In the middle of January we got the word to close up shop and try to be out of Denmark by the end of the month. Well - that just looked like a totally impossible situation. We were right in the middle of a couple of projects - things that were ready to be printed - we had 4 big caravans to sell, 2 cars, plus a house full of things to get rid of, including survival for about a year! So you can understand we were really desperate in prayer about making it. When considering all these things, we got the verse 1.Sam.15:22, "To obey is better than sacrifice". So we just stopped the work where it was, and started working on packing, selling things, finding out about visas and tickets, plus shipping. The whole Lit-Pic - about 13 people including children - decided to go to Thailand, as that was where it seemed there were open doors.
