When you're talking and witnessing to others, the first & most important thing to show them is that you love them! You show them this by showing concern about them & interest in them, and the way you do that is by asking questions about themselves & their life. That's what most people need most of all, just somebody to show an interest in them.

What you have to get through your heads is that you're trying to show God's love to a lost soul, a sinner who needs it, trying to show him compassion, trying to show him that you love him \(\xi\) you're trying to make him \(\hat{happy}\) by giving him what he \(\frac{needs}{s} \xi\) likes. — If you don't want to sit there \(\frac{all}{night}\) long and listen to their life story, then you don't love them! Once they've given you their whole story, then you can begin to give them all the answers to their problems—Scriptures, Love of God.

Ask questions about their life. Let them do most of the talking nearly all the time until finally something is said or something is done that opens the door for you to witness. But for God's sake, don't just get up there & start preaching at them!

have to feel something, yes. But then you have to tell them why: "It's Jesus!" You have to tell them how they can receive Jesus, and the only way they will know is by the Word and what the Bible says!

These four steps are all you really need to show them that they are saved: 1. Confess sin first of all 2. Believe Christ. 3. Receive Christ. 4. Confess Christ.

The best order to use the 7 verses of Salvation would be:

- 1. First of all you're a sinner: Romans 3:23.
- 2. Next, you can't save yourself: Ephesians 2:8-9.
- 3. Then, only believing on Jesus can save you: John 3:16.
- 4. Then, on receiving Him: John 1:12.
